Key Provisions For Commercial Cultivation

1. Cap number of cultivation permits (and acres) per watershed to near current total number (to~1,200 permits, not 3,500 per County resolution)
2. No new or expanded cultivation permits >10,000 sq ft
3. Liquor license process for new cultivation permits (\leq 10,000 sq ft), if below cap
4. No multiple cultivation permits per person/corporation or per parcel; no other types of permits are considered
5. Category 4 roads assessed by engineer, if new or expanded permit
6. Must store sufficient water, or cut back crop – add storage
7. Phase out generators, except one emergency 50 hp
8. Hydrologic study for new wells must prove no negative impacts
9. Water diversion from streams reduced by one month
10. Only Outdoor, Tier 1 mixed light, or nursery for new permits
11. At least one on-site, in-person inspection per year, \leq 24 hrs notice
12. Limited one-year term of cultivation permit, renew annually
13. County to investigate all public complaints
14. Cultivation permit expires if requirements are not met within renewal period
15. County must notify neighborhoods about cultivation permit applications
16. No waiver of public hearings
17. County to coordinate and collaborate with state agencies
